PRIVATE PARTY ROOM - SEATS UP TO 30

- \$40 Reservation Fee plus \$40 per hour, plus tax
- Tables and chairs included
- Available during regular operating hours only
- No minimum bar purchase just order at the bar (ask us about how you can treat your guests to beer)

THE BARREL ROOM - PARTIES OF 40 or more

- Available during and after business hours
- 60' x 27' plus a separate private bar area
- \$200 per hour (Fri Sun) \$100 per hour (Mon Thurs) for space rental
- Rental packages for tables/chairs/linens and other decor options are available
- Bar Minimum is \$700 for a 3 hour event and \$100 each additional hour plus 18% gratuity.

WAYS TO MEET YOUR BEER MINIMUM

Bar Minimums may be met by:

- Purchasing open bar
- Running an open tab (you may set the limit to the beer minimum purchase if you wish)
- Giving out tickets to your guests to be redeemed for a beer/seltzer(s) on your tab
- Asking your guests to pay for their own beer/seltzer, and any sales short of the minimum is charged to you, the host.
- A combination of above plus purchase of packaged beer/seltzer to take home/give to guests

Open Bar: \$25 per person

- If open bar option is selected, it must be purchased for all guests of drinking age in party.
- Open Bar Includes all beverages and draft beers with the exception of barrel aged beers.
- \$25 per person for up to a 3 hour party (last call 15 minutes before end of party).
- Additional open bar prorated at \$3 per person + tax per additional 30 minutes.

FUNDRAISERS

- If you are hosting a fundraiser we will donate back 20% of your party's beer purchase towards your approved non-profit.
- Available during regular taproom hours on Fridays and Sundays.
- Available with some additional provisions during taproom hours on Saturdays.
- Fundraising events are may not solicit OBH patrons from the general public.
- Contact us for a worksheet on your fundraising event.

FAQ's

- Q. Can I offer wine at my event?
- A. You are permitted to get your own banquet license for wine for private events in the Barrel Room with the following restrictions: 1. Your event must be closed to the public. 2. You must purchase open bar for your guests. 3. You, or your caterer, must have a banquet license for the serving of alcohol at the event. 4. We use our glasses, and our servers to pour. Please contact us to discuss if offering wine is an option for your event.
- Q. Can I bring in outside food and use other vendors?
- A. Yes! We welcome all outside food, catering and other vendors (DJs, bands, decorators etc..).
- Q. When do I pay for open bar for my guests if I don't know how many guests are going to show up?
- A. You can pay for open bar in blocks on the day of your event and hand out wrist bands as your guests arrive. If you did not purchase enough, you can purchase more as needed as guests arrive. If you purchase too many, we can credit any overage over the minimum beer purchase for your rental.
- Q. If I don't meet my beer minimum can I buy packaged beer to take home to make up the difference?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Are children permitted at our event?
- A. Yes. We offer root beer and root beer floats that are favorites with guests of all ages. We also offer Coke, Diet Coke and Sprite, in addition to water and Kombucha as non-alcoholic alternatives.
